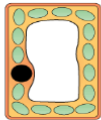

*Students will complete their GCSE studies by the end of February and then focus on revision in preparation for the exams in the summer. Topics studied in year 11 are:*



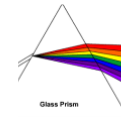
### Biology
