

## Year 7- Tudors

### Title: Did religion change after Henry VII's death?

Henry VIII died in 1547, he had 3 children who all became King or Queen of England. Edward VI took the throne after Henry VIII first, despite being the youngest! The throne of England was inherited by boys first (known as Primogeniture).
