“Quel temps fait-il?”

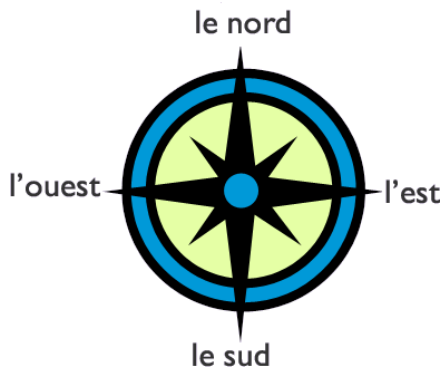
Tasks 1 and 2 are to be completed in your blue book.
