- **Pop Art** - had its origins in England in the 1950s and made its way to the United States during the 1960s.
- Pop Art brought art back to the material realities of everyday life, to popular culture (hence the term 'pop').
- Pop artists focused attention upon familiar images of popular culture such as billboards, comic strips, magazine advertisements, and supermarket products. They often took inspiration from Pop music, Movies and the fashion industry.
- Although starting in England, America quickly took over as the centre of the Pop Art revolution.

- **Leading British Artists:** Richard Hamilton, David Hockney, Eduardo Paolozzi, Peter Blake.
