The “root” is the basic part of a word that has meaning and can have a prefix or suffix added to it.

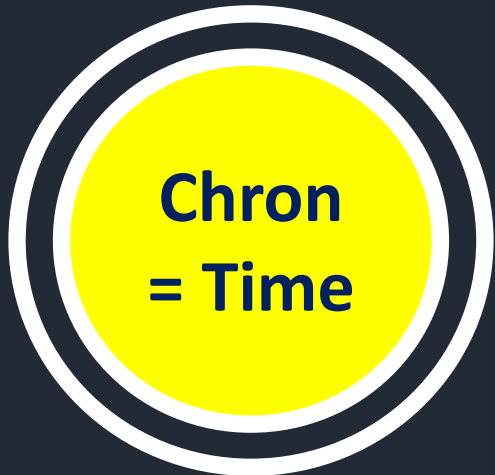
