Word Roots

The “root” is the basic part of a word that has meaning and can have a prefix or suffix added to it.

This week we will be focusing on words which use the Latin word ‘Trans’ which means ‘across’

Trans =

Transgender = People whose gender identity is different from the gender they were thought to be at birth.  **Transitioned ‘across’ genders.**

Transfer = Diaz transferred to Liverpool on transfer deadline day.  **Moved ‘across’ clubs.**

Translate = Express the sense of (words or text) in another language.  **Carry one language ‘across’ to another.**
