Passport to Prom 2024

As we approach the end of Year 11, we are excited to be thinking about the celebrations that are occurring to commemorate the five years students have spent with us at Sybil Andrews.

One of these events is the Prom. We will soon be sending out information regarding Prom tickets and how these can be ordered. However, ahead of this, we wanted to ensure that we communicate with parents and carers about the Passport to Prom. The Passport to Prom is the criteria we will set out to ensure that students can attend the Prom, scheduled for Wednesday 10th July. To attend the Prom, students must meet the three criteria which are set out below:

- 1. Students must have an average Go 4 Schools overall points score of 1 or above. This means for every negative point collected, students must have 2 positive points.
- 2. Students must not accrue more than 4 internal exclusions.
- 3. Students must attend at least 5 revision/intervention sessions.

This will run from Monday 11th March to Friday 31st May 2024 and we believe this gives every pupil the chance to succeed and attend the Prom. For clarity; for the Passport to Prom we will only take into account behaviour events from the 11th March to 31st of May – historic behaviour events (i.e. before the 11th March 2024) will not be included in the Passport to Prom.

We are hopeful that every Year 11 student will be able to meet the criteria set out above. However, we are clear that if students do not meet the criteria set, they will be unable to attend the Prom.
