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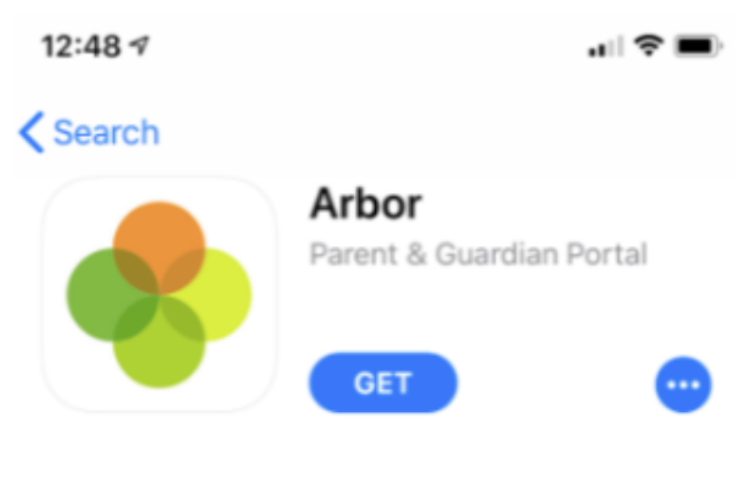

GOOD HABITS TODAY, GREAT RESULTS TOMORROW

- 1 HAVE A PROPER WORKSPACE**
Set up a clear, well-lit area away from noise and distractions so you can focus and work calmly.
- 2 ARRANGE YOUR TIME**
Create a regular homework routine. Don't spend too long on one task — balance effort with breaks and rest.
- 3 BLOCK OUT DISTRACTIONS**
Put phones and devices out of sight and hearing. Fewer interruptions mean better focus and faster work.
- 4 INTEGRATE TECHNOLOGY WISELY**
Use computers for research, quizzes or information when needed — but stay on task and avoid drifting off-track.
- 5 TAKE AN ACTIVE APPROACH**
Make your revision active:
 - make revision cards
 - test yourself
 - complete online quizzes
 - rewrite notes and highlight key points
 - draw diagrams
 - record ideas and listen back
 - plan essays and turn plans into flashcards
- 6 STRENGTHEN YOUR LEARNING**
Review your work, check accuracy, and build steady habits that help you improve over time.
